Registration

Registration to the meeting will be made on Monday when arriving in the UK Met Office where you will be receiving your badge for the week as well as a Participant kit.

Due to security issues, all IDs will be checked upon arrival: *please do not forget to bring your ID. Entry to the Met Office will not be permitted if you can't present your passport.*

Lunches and coffee breaks

Buffet lunches and coffee breaks (one in the morning and one in the afternoon) will be provided by our hosts on each day. In the Met Office, they will be available on the Balcony, next to the Plenary room (2nd floor).

In the University, breaks and lunch buffets will be available in the Atrium except:

Transportation from and to the hotels

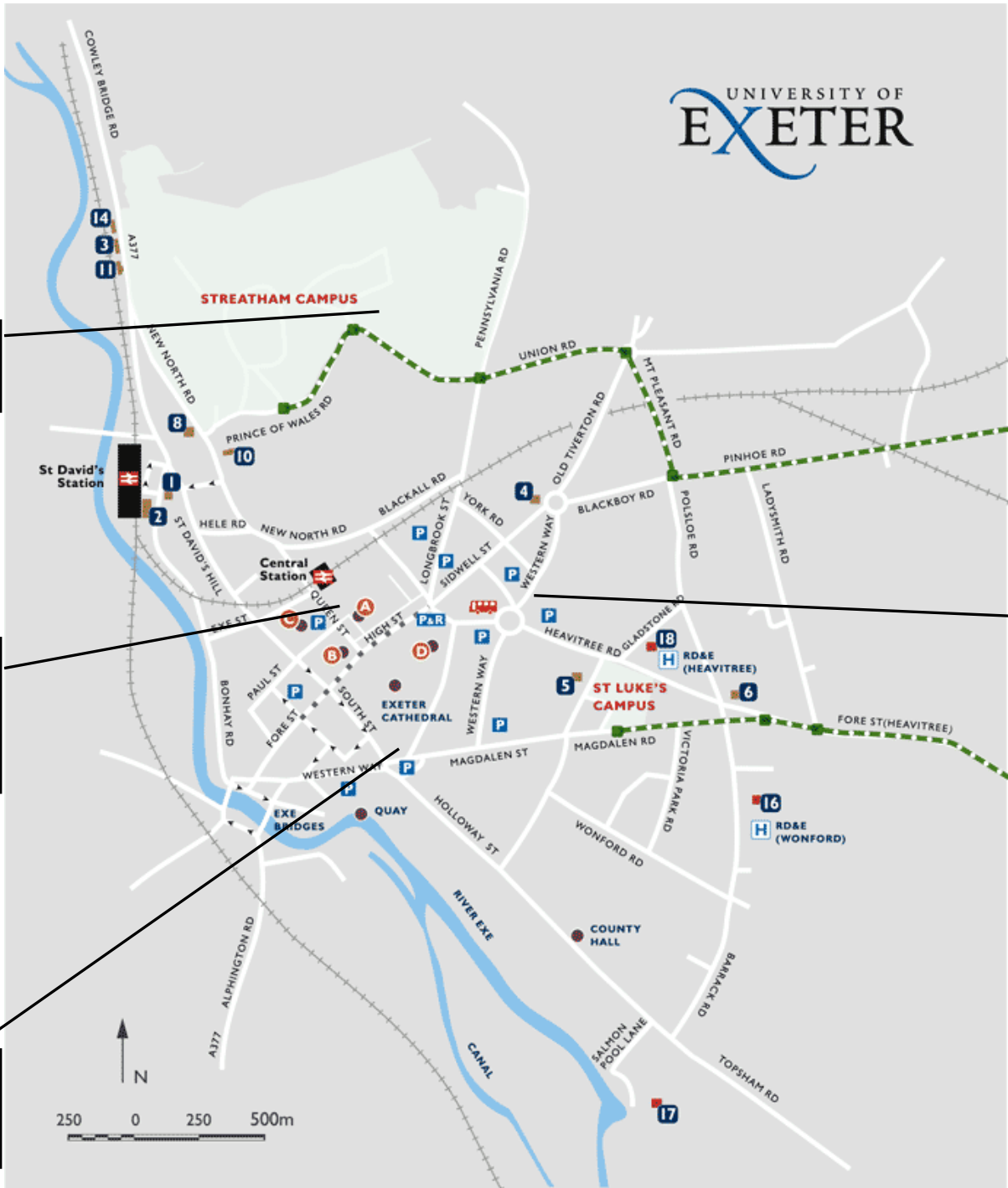
LAM2 participants who wish can have a quick lunch at the Farmers' Market located on the campus.

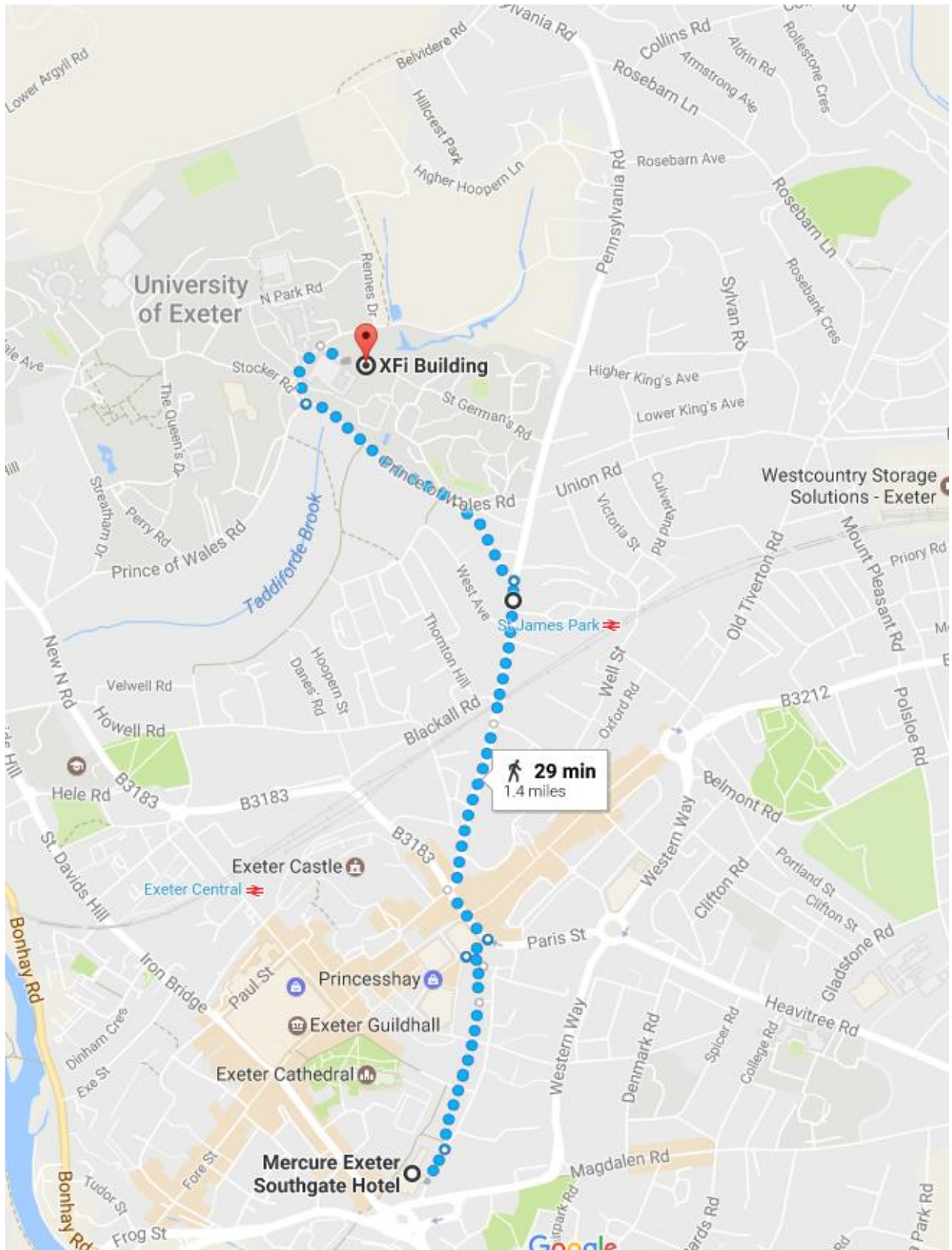
